To date, there have been only five civilian withdrawals, and those for health, military, and miscellaneous reasons.

The freshman class claims the greatest number of students with 849 enrolled; the sophomores second with 574; and the junior and senior classes are 115 and 156, respectively. There are 31 students in special and auditor classes and 54 graduates. The liberal arts course has the greatest number of students, with a total of 960.
