

Wesley House to Locate on Onyx

The property on which the house was formerly located at 1258 Kincaid has been sold, and Wesley Foundation is purchasing a new house through pledges from local and state Methodist churches, Mrs. Don Durland (Velita Estey), president of the foundation, reports.

The student director, Mrs. Paul Hurlecker (Mary Beth Carpenter), will live at the house; there will also be six rooms for Methodist girls and two garages for rent. With increased facilities for studying, meetings and receration, the house will be open at all times to all students. With the house, now used as a private dwelling, is a spacious backyord with a fireplace.


