



# They Came To Anoint His Body



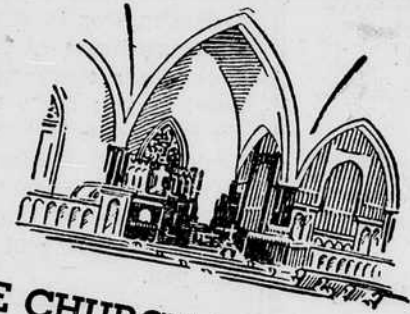
