The University Vesper choir, directed by Johnette King, junior in music, will present a spring concert at Reedsport, Oregon, April 30.

UO's Vesper Choir To Sing in Reedsport

The Women's Choral club of Eugene will present its spring concert at McArthur court at 8:15 April 30. The chorus of 74 voices will be under the direction of Glenn Griffith of the Eugene high school.

The club is featured semi-annually in a fall and a spring concert. The guest artist will be George Hopkins, assistant professor of piano at the music school, who will play selections from Debussy, Chopin, and Elmerco. The numbers will include the popular "Polanaise in A-Flat" and the Golliwog's "Cake Walk."

Margery Scobert Wilson will accompany the group. Featured contralto parts will be sung by Marguerite Saunders and the soprano obligato parts by Doris Siegenthaler, Rea Rice, and Elizabeth Walker.

The program will be varied, including the "United Nations March" by Shostokovich, "Serenade" by Schubert, and a popular number, "Love Walked In" by George Gershwin. Other familiar numbers by well-known composers will complete the program.
