Vets' 'R' Course Deadline June 8

The University veterans' office announces the faculty regulation governing "refresher courses": "Veterans may, during the first academic year of their registration, use any University course as a refresher course, indicating the grade status by an 'R' in the grade column of the registration card. Changes to and from 'R' registration may be made in the same way as any other course changes, with special weight given to recommendations of the veterans' administrator."

When an 'R' is granted a student in a particular course, no grade should be reported by the instructor on the term grade sheet. A student granted a refresher course must keep up his attendance, or the refresher status may be changed to "withdrawn," in which case the hours of instruction would be lost to the veteran student. The spring-term deadline for refresher course petitions is June 8.

WASHINGTON, May 15.—(UP)—President Truman conferred with UMW boss John L. Lewis and a representative of the mine owners tonight in an effort to break the bargaining stalemate and head off a resumption of the coal strike when the present two-week truce ends May 25.

WASHINGTON, May 15.—(UP)—Secretary of the Treasury Fred M. Vinson conceded that the proposed \$3,750,000,000 loan to Great Britain would leave the world split into two great economic blocs—Russia on one side and the United States and Great Britain on the other.

PARIS, May 15.—(UP)—Russia rejected urgent American proposals to hold a conference in July on axis satellite peace treaties, but the big four foreign ministers agreed to revise armistice terms for Italy, in an attempt to get her back to normal, before they adjourn Thursday until June 15.

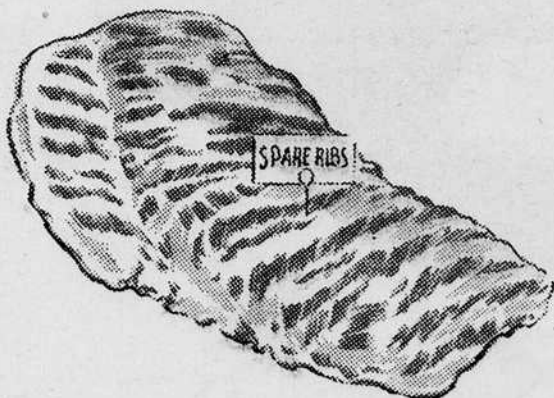

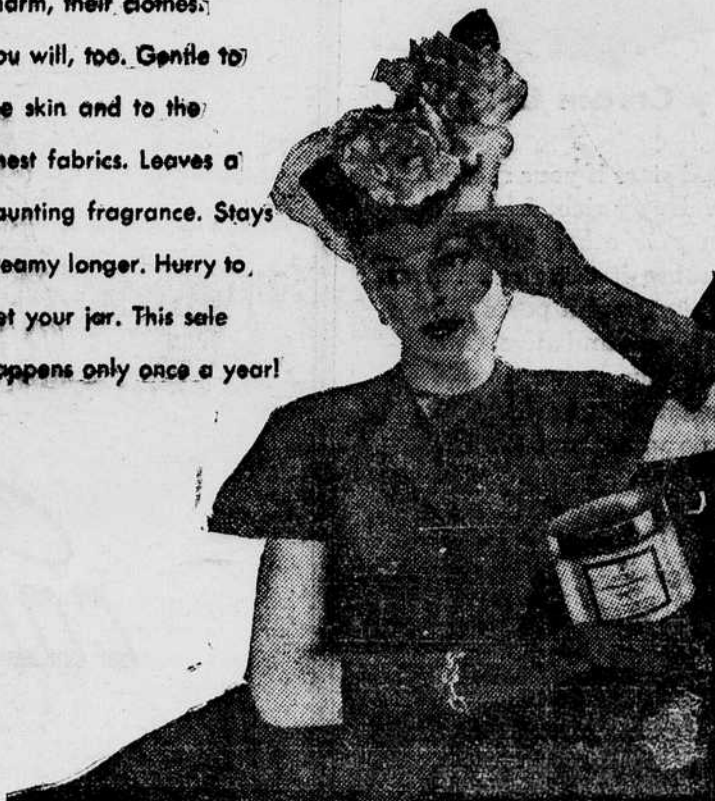
