

# Vets Adviser Sets Schedule

The following instructions for veteran students have been issued by George L. Hall, assistant dean of men in charge of veterans' affairs. Veterans should follow these instructions carefully, Mr. Hall emphasized, in order to insure efficient registration.

1. All veterans registering this term must call at the University Veterans' Office (Basement, Johnson Hall) for a 1946-47 veteran's card. This card will be the veterans' identification and no veteran can proceed with registration without it. Old cards will not be honored. The office will issue cards from Monday, September 16, through registration.

2. Veterans who are entering the

University for the first time or former Oregon students who have not previously attended the University under the servicemen's readjustment act of 1944 (public law 16 or 246) must have a certificate of eligibility and entitlement (veterans' administration form 1953).

If the veteran does not have a certificate of eligibility he should apply immediately to the veterans' administration on their application form No. 1950.

### Temporary Card

3. If the veteran does not have his certificate of eligibility in time for registration, it may be possible for him to make arrangements for a temporary letter with the veterans' administration guidance center located in the men's physical education building.

This is a temporary device and will not start subsistence payments, but when presented to the University veterans' office will entitle the veteran to his veteran's

card. When his certificate of eligibility arrives he must surrender it at once to the University veterans' office.

4. If the veteran is a transfer and has been attending some other college or university under the servicemen's readjustment act, he must have a supplementary certificate of eligibility or some written evidence of his eligibility which the local veterans' administration can use to issue a temporary letter to the University.

### Other Vets

5. Veterans who do not have a certificate of eligibility and who do not have sufficient evidence of eligibility to have the local veterans' administration issue a temporary letter must pay their own tuition and buy their own books and supplies.

Arrangements will be made for refunds of tuition, books, and sup-

plies when the eligibility is established. Receipts must be kept and refunds will be made for all that the government will pay under the servicemen's readjustment act of 1944.

### Board Names Newburn

### All Vets Must Get Card

All veterans registering at the University this term must first call at the University Veterans' Office (basement, Johnson) for a 1946-47 veteran's card. This card will be the veteran's identification and no veteran can proceed with registration without it. Old cards will not be honored. The veterans' office will issue 1946-47 veteran's cards from Monday, September 16, through registration.
