

# Univerisity Coed Receives Hawaiian 'Dreamboat' Mail

When the Army B-29 "Pacusan Dreamboat" took off on its record hop from Honolulu, Hawaii, to Cairo, Egypt, it carried a crew of nine men, 77,351 pounds of gasoline and three letters. Yesterday, a University woman received one of the letters. From Honolulu to Cairo to Eugene, the letter had travelled approximately 20,000 air miles. The letter was mailed in Cairo by the "Dreamboat's" navigator, and was written by "Buck" Buchwach, '42, now a reporter on the Honolulu Daily Advertiser. In his senior year at Oregon, Buchwach

was president of Sigma Delta Chi, national professional men's journalistic fraternity, and attended the national convention in New Orleans in 1941.

Buchwach was one of four correspondents traveling from Hilo, Hawaii, to California last August aboard a B-29 which guided the first long distance radio-controlled plane flight in airplane history.
