

# UN Assembly Hear Student Post-war Plan

NEW YORK, Oct. 25 (AP)—The United Nations assembly will hear what a bloc of college students think might be done about whipping the world into shape.

Lois McConkey Putnam, the 21-year-old economic major who was chosen as one of the delegates, is a popular blonde who was chairman

of the rally squad and Junior Week-end Princess at the University of Oregon.

Lois Strong, the other delegate, is a good-looking veteran of 19 months in the Army Air corps, a former aircraft design engineer, who is studying at the College of Puget Sound, Tacoma, Wash. He hopes to enter the Methodist ministry. He's been married three years.

They both, along with several thousand others, argue that the world, if nobody takes an interest in it, displays a lamentable tendency to go to pot. They don't want another war. 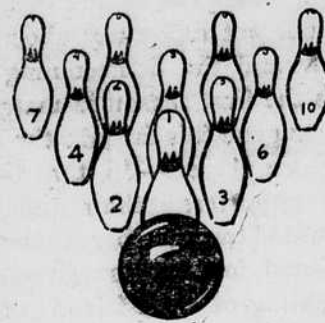
