Nylon Hose Thief Caught in Portland

PORLAND, Nov. 22—(AP)—Six thousand pair of nylon stockings led today to the arrest of a man who had recently opened stocking stores in Portland and Seattle.

James Purcell, chief of detectives, identified the man as Joseph Lewis Mansour, 26, indicted by a Multnomah county grand jury on a charge of grand larceny.

Purcell said the 6000 pair of stockings arrived here by air from New York Aug. 3, consigned to Harry Bernow. Purcell said they were picked up by another man and wound up in Mansour's possession. Purcell said Mansour refused to answer questions, and in the meanwhile police are looking for Bernow, in whose behalf a suit was filed against the air line that carried the hose. The suit charges Bernow never received his shipment.
