

## Award Goes To Top Student

Martha E. Smith, sophomore in chemistry, has been awarded the 1946-47 Mackenzie Memorial scholarship.

She is entitled to a \$200 scholarship as the outstanding premedical student at the University. The committee recommendation is based on her high scholastic attainment and general fitness for medical training.

The scholarship is renewable for each of four years of medical training at the University of Oregon medical school in Portland.

The fund was established in 1940 by a \$250,000 bequest to the University from the will of Mrs. Mildred Anna Williams.

The fund was named for the late Kenneth A. J. Mackenzie, first dean of the University medical school.

Each year the University premedical and predoctoral advisory committee selects the outstanding premedical student for the award. This year members are: P. L. Risley, head of the biology department; A. E. Caswell, head of the physics department; A. H. Kunz, head of the chemistry department.

Last year Eileen Marie Breneman was the fifth recipient and first woman to benefit by the scholarship.

In 1915 there were 16 fraternal organizations on the University of Oregon campus.

## Senator Morse to Talk At Memorial Banquet

WASHINGTON, Feb. 5—(AP) Senator Morse (R-Ore) said today he had accepted an invitation to deliver an address at the Willkie memorial banquet in New York February 18 and that he felt honored by being selected.

He said in a formal statement that the late Wendell Willkie was one of "the greatest and soundest liberal Republicans my party has ever produced."

Morse said he cancelled Lincoln day speeches in Washington state because his doctor had ordered him to rest his throat. He made 13 speeches in five days on a trip to Oregon from which he returned Monday.
