'47 Oregana Ranks In Stellar Position

Verification that only five year-books in the country, besides the 1947 Oregana, were presented the top award for college yearbooks was received yesterday by Ross Yates, editor of the 1948 Oregana.

The news appeared in the December issue of "Scholastic Editor", the national magazine for all student publications.

Awards of "All-American Honor Rating" were neted by "The Blue Pint," Georgia School of Technology, Atlanta; "The Cornhusker", University of Nebraska, Lincoln; "The Royal Purple", Kansas State College, Manhatan; "Taps", Clemson College, S. Car.; "The Yucca", North Texas State Teachers College, Denton.

The 1947 Oregana, edited by Roy Paul Nelson, was the only publication on the West Coast to merit this honor. No Pacemaker awards were presented this year.
