

### UO Press Head To Resign Soon; Successor Told

Fred A. Beard of Chicago, Illinois, has been named to succeed Robert C. Hall as superintendent of the University of Oregon press following Hall's retirement, July 1. The appointment, which was announced by President Harry K. Newburn, will be presented to the state board of higher education for confirmation at their next meeting.

Beard is superintendent of the press at Moody Bible institute. He was at the Good News press in Chicago prior to that. He is a college graduate and has had practical experience in college printing and publication at the University of Chicago press. For twelve years he was affiliated with the Iowa state college press, where he also lectured at the college. Beard will hold the rank of assistant professor of journalism at the University of Oregon.

Hall has been charge of the press since 1917. He came here under the late Dean Eric W. Allen about six months after the founding of the press.

### Spanish Profs Select Wright

At the annual meeting of the American Association of Teachers of Spanish and Portuguese in Detroit, Michigan from Dember 27-29, Dr. Leavitt Olds Wright, professor of Romance languages at the University of Oregon, was elected president for 1948.

Dr. Wright is the author of some 30 articles published in language periodicals including Hispania, official publication of the association. He has also published a book of Spanish verb forms.

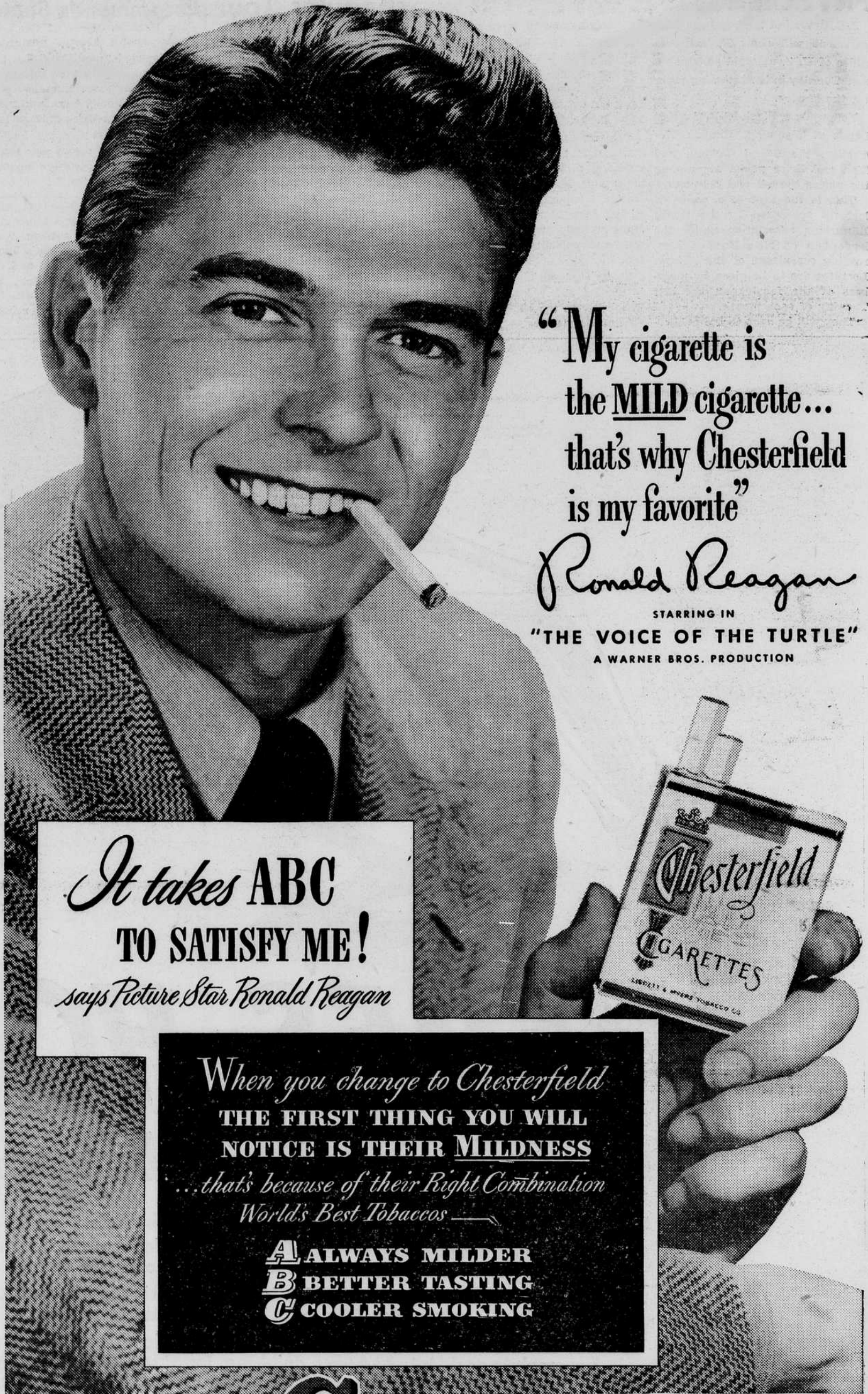
Wright was president of Sigma Delta Pi, national Spanish honorary, from 1925 to 1937. He is now a member of the executive council.

Under the leadership of Wright future plans for the association include two new chapters in Oregon, in Eugene and Klamath Falls. The only present chapter in Oregon is the branch in Portland. About 3600 members are in the association.

Other Oregon faculty members who attended the meeting in Detroit were: Dr. D. M. Daugherty, head of the foreign language department, Dr. Philip M. Sours, head of the English department, and Dr. Chandler B. Beall, professor of Romance languages. These men also attended the Modern Language association meeting and the annual meeting of Sigma Delta Pi.
