For young women interested in personnel work and other branches of administration, a limited number of fellowships covering tuition fees in whole or in part for the 1948-49 year are being offered by Radcliffe college. In addition to the fellowships there are openings for a limited number of college graduates. The tuition is \$550.

The program includes about seven months of class instruction given by members of the faculty of the graduate school of business administration from Harvard university and others. Selected full time apprentice work in business, government and other organizations occupies about three months.
