Ex O.S.S. Man To Address Science Group

Dr. Samuel N. Dicken, head of the department of geology and geography, will speak on the topographical features of "caves and karst" Tuesday at 8 p. m. This lecture will be presented to the members of Sigma Xi, national science honorary, in Room 103 Deady hall.

Dr. Dicken will tell of his experiences in geological surveys of cave and karst areas and of his work with the American O.S.S. during the war. Dr. Dicken will discuss the evolution of karstment of limestone formations. He (roofless caves) and the developed an intensive study of this subject while on a Kentucky geological survey in 1937 and while serving with the O. S. S. during the war.

It was when Dr. Dicken was affiliated with the O.S.S., he prepared a detailed report of cave formations in Germany. It was thought at that time that fanatic bands of the German army and SS men would use these cave areas as fortresses from which to continue resistance against American troops.

Members of Sigma Xi have scheduled a closed meeting at 7:30 p. m. preceding Dr. Dicken's speech to the honorary and to the general public.
