Laurence LeSage, assistant professor of Romance languages, published an article in the March issue of "The French Review," a publication devoted to the interest of French teachers.

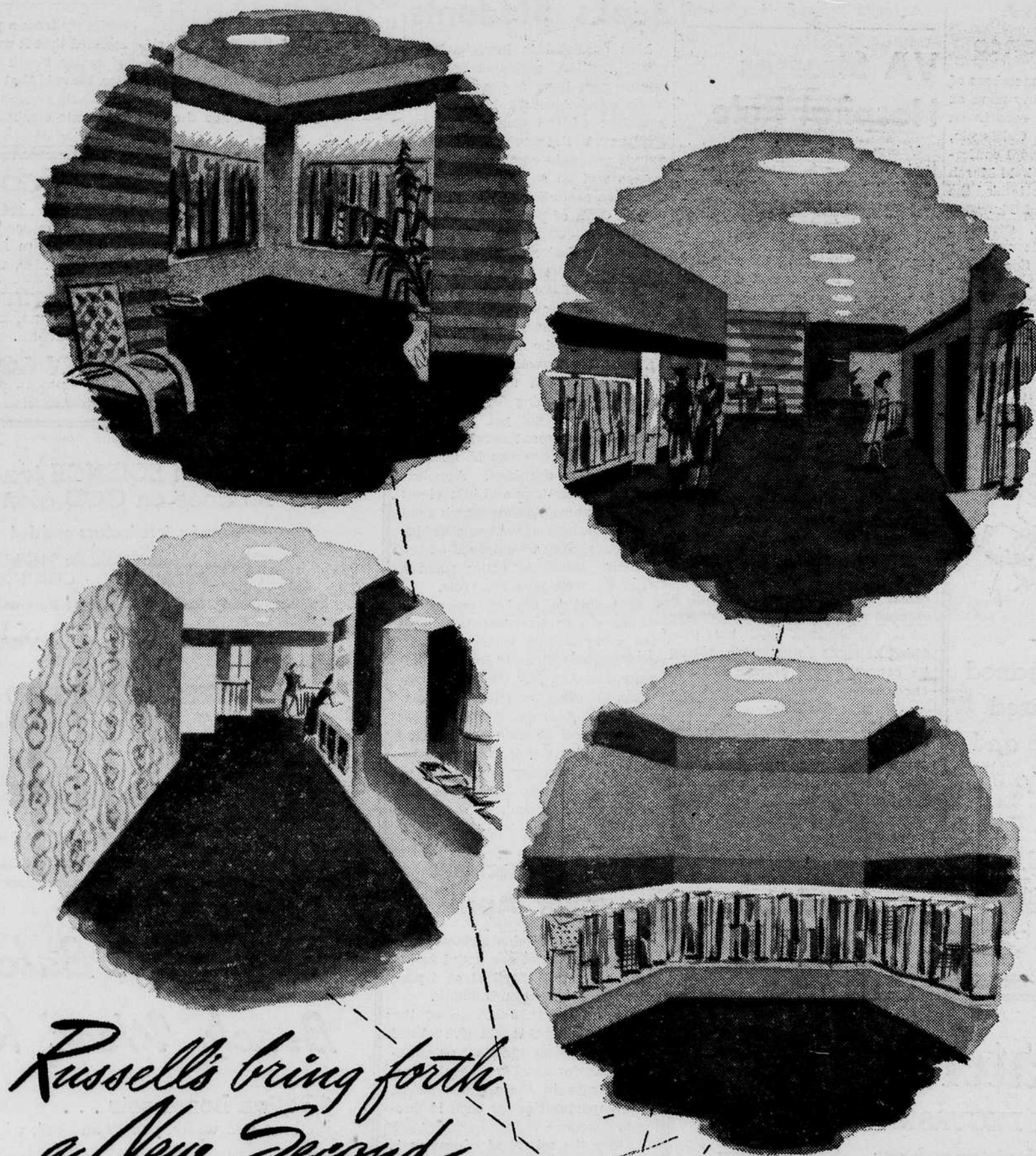
