Cressmen Head Faculty Probe Of Registration

Upon request of faculty motion, President Harry K. Newburn has appointed a faculty committee to investigate the registration system at the University.

This committee has already polled student and faculty groups asking for their recommendations on registration and advising on the campus. It will study the recommendations and formulate suggestions on registration. Completion of the project will require some time, L. S. Cressman, committee chairman, said yesterday.

Members of the committee are L. S. Cressman, head of the anthropology dept.; C. L. Huffaker, professor of education; V, S. Sprague, assistant professor of physical education; R. R. Huestis, professor of zoology; F. A. Cuthbert, associate professor of land architecture; C. P. Schleicher, professor of political science; W. C. Ballaine, professor of business administration and economics. C. E. Avery, registrar, and C. L. Constance, associate registrar, will also assist in the study.

(Continued from page one) enemy—true issues and false—was stressed by the professor.

An example of inability to do this is Harold Stassen, according to Dr. Schleicher. He said Stassen is "unable to distinguish between socialism and communism." Another example was the "stupid move" by the house of representatives to send aid to fascist Spain.

Italy's election may help halt communism in Europe if "we attempt to increase democratic forces of social progress" and "work with the Italians, not using them as tools," he declared.

Most of the world is neither communistic nor capitalistic, according to Dr. Schleicher. If democratic people of Europe were given their choice of capitalism or socialism, the latter would be their choice, he said.
