

## Vets Can Save Eligibility By Cancelling Vacation Checks

GI eligibility under PL 346 may be conserved by those who are running short on time or expect to be before completing their education by cancelling subsistence checks over the Christmas vacation. In order to do so application must be made 30 days before the end of the fall term, according to Donald Schworer, campus representative for the VA.

Schworer warned that no veteran should do this, however, unless he has enough money to tide him over until he receives another check, as the January check will be delayed for a period approximately equal to

that encountered this fall. Time may also be conserved by cancelling the 15 day automatic leave granted by the veterans administration at the end of the regular school year, Schworer explained. The VA must be notified 30 days in advance to do this also.

This plan is especially advantageous to those veterans training under Public Law 346 who anticipate the expiration of their eligibility before the middle of a term. If this occurs, the veteran will be expected to pay the tuition for the remainder of the term. If he has enough eligibility to make it past the half-
