

Professors to Give Papers at Conference

Dr. Zenon Szatrowski, associate professor of economics, F. J. Massey, assistant professor of mathematics, and W. J. Dixon, associate professor of mathematics, will give papers on the University of Washington campus at a joint conference being held there by the Institute of Mathematical Statistics and the Biometric society, November 26 and 27.

Dr. Szatrowski, who speaks on November 26, will talk on "Stationary Time Series Analysis and Common Stock Price Forecasting," which will discuss the operations of the New York stock market. His paper will show some of the recently developed techniques in mathematical statistics and how they can

be used in solving practical problems which confront the forecaster on the stock market and problems of a similar nature, Dr. Szatrowski said.

Professor Massey will speak on "Some Numerical Comparisons of a Non-Parametric Test with other Tests," which will discuss a particular problem in mathematical statistics.

Professor Massey worked with the Statistical Laboratory, University of California, during 1943-45, on various naval problems, under contracts from the OSRD, principally on material connected with relative accuracy and methods of bombing.

Professor Dixon will discuss "On the Deviation of Extreme Values,"

which will be in the field of statistical analysis. Professor Dixon worked for Operations Analysis during World War II, under the Princeton group, and the OSRD and the NDRC. In connection with his work for Operations Analysis, he spent a brief period on Guam with the Twentieth Air Force.
