

# Beck Receives Trial Copies of 'Growth' Film

Three hundred test copies of the publication, "Human Growth" arrived on the campus this week for distribution by Dr. Lester F. Beck, associate professor of psychology, who prepared it with the assistance of Margie Robinson, graduate student in psychology.

"Human Growth," which deals with biological facts of the growth of the human body and contains details on child-birth, was written especially for junior-high school children and their parents, according to Dr. Beck. It was a year in preparation and draws from years of study and testing. The book is

based on the nationally applauded film of the same name for which Dr. Beck acted as consultant and which was sponsored by the E. C. Brown trust and the University of Oregon.

These test copies of "Human Growth" are for distribution to select groups in Eugene and Portland and to school administrators and officials in the field of visual education who attend the American Association of School Administrators conference in San Francisco February 22-23.

The book will be revised before its May release by Harcourt, Brace and Company, according to the reactions of the test groups.

Dr. Beck will attend the School Administrators conference and will be a dinner speaker February 22, discussing the topic, "Human Growth"—"Its Origin and Its Us-

es"—"What's Coming Next in this Field?"

Dr. Beck will also lead a discussion, on the sex education film project of the University and the E. C. Brown Trust fund. Assisting him will be John Fletcher, Eddie Albert, who produced the film "Human Growth" and is now working on a series of productions in the same field, will attend if possible.

The conference will include general sessions and special discussion groups dealing with phases of Dr. Beck's movie and other movies in this field.

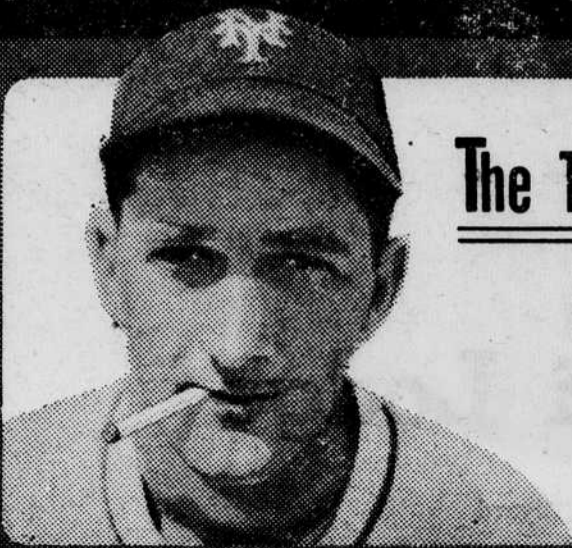
