Annual Service Set for Sunrise Easter Morning

"Easter Triple Victory" will be the topic of Morgan S. Odell, president of Lewis and Clark college, when he addresses the Easter Sunrise service April 17 at 6 a.m. in McArthur court. In this talk, Dr. Odell will deal with the meaning of Easter for the individual, man's hope for eternal life and his hope for a kingdom of God among men on earth. President Harry K. Newburn will introduce the guest speaker.

The processional and recessional will be played by the Eugene Junior Symphony orchestra. The audience will sing "Christ, the Lord Is Risen Today."

Led by Mrs. Margery Wilson, the Roosevelt Junior Choir will sing "Adoramus" by Palestrina, "Sanctus" from the "Saint Cecilia Mass" by Gounod, and "Cherubin Song" by Bartniewsky. James Kayes will sing a solo, "Sanctus" by Gounod.

Rev. Vance Webster of the Baptist church, Rev. J. L. Sawyer of the United Lutheran church, Rev. Richard S. Taylor of the First Church of the Nazarene, and Rev. David Seaman from Wesley foundation will also participate in the service.

The Eugene-Springfield Community Interdenominational Easter Sunrise service this year is being sponsored by the University Religious council and the Eugene Ministerial association. Arthur Elbon, Jr. is the student chairman for the service and Cleone Olson is the adult adviser from the University Religious council.

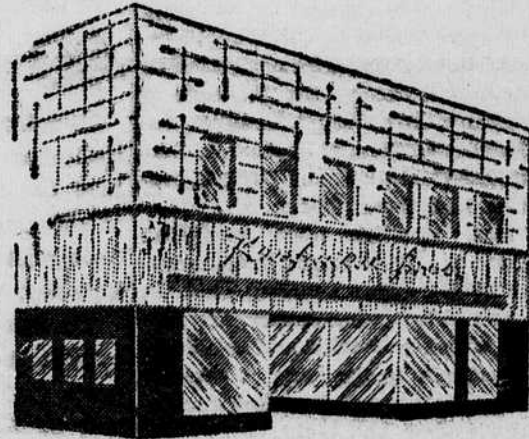
