

Hidden Garden Almost Unknown

Amide the 38 buildings of the 130-acre campus of the University of Oregon, there is to be found a memorial court containing a bust of Prince L. Campbell, fourth president of the University.

The bust is mounted under a gold mosaic dome at the eastern end of a little garden, containing a fountain and a small rectangular, tile bottomed pools.

Students passing back and forth on their way to classes often pass what is the most tranquil spot on the campus, the innards of the projecting east end of the museum building.

The garden may be entered from the museum proper or from a gate to be found at the southern tip of

the east wing. Time was when the garden knew the hushed voices "of wolves and their mates." University officials brought this to an end.

The leaves of Oregon float in sky reflecting water where trout had darted once. Trout lives have long been extinguished while gasping for air, flopping about on the green velvet soft grass. The quietude of the pool was conducive to a continual growth. Fish, like men, occasionally grasp out for tantalizing tidbits and in so doing come to an untimely end.

Under the sun's highest arc, during a hot summer day, what sights the bronze eyed bust has

seen. Milky white skin exposed in memorial court, the record shows.

Open up the garden gate and push the records far from sight. That could be the plea for those standing in the spring rain, look forward to the sun's return.

Youth slow down your running pace. Step from the race and enter into the memorial grounds. Look heavenward in beauty, and quietude and grace. Breathe deeply here—then run like hell for class.

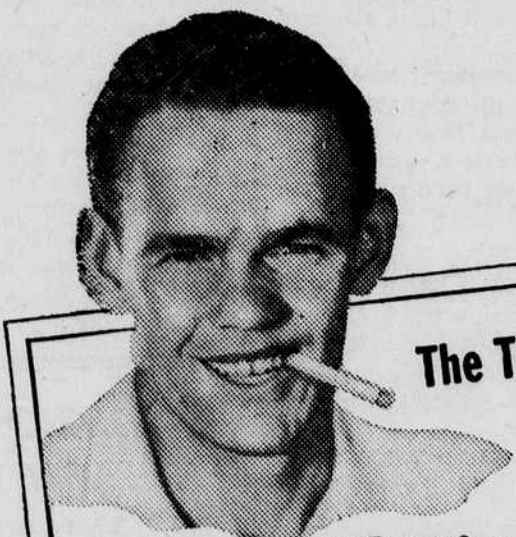
(Continued from page six) amount of good in speeding higher wages and better working conditions, which in turn brings a higher standard of living for us all.
