Dr. John Tilson Ganoe, professor of history in the University of Oregon since 1930, died Thursday, at the age of 49 years, in a Portland hospital following an illness of several months duration.

Memorial services for Professor Ganoe will be held at 1:30 Saturday at the Congregational church in Eugene.
