Seaplane Giant Hauls 308 Men

SAN DIEGO, Calif., May 19—(AP)—The giant Marshall Mars navy flying boat—with a record load of 308 men—landed here this afternoon on a flight from the naval air station at Alameda, Calif.

The huge plane carried 301 passengers—plus seven crewmen. The total is 39 greater than any previous load. A sister-ship, the Caroline Mars, carried the previous record load of 269 passengers on a flight from San Diego to Alameda March 4.

Commander James C. Long of Mapleton, Minn., piloted the four-engined flying boat on today's flight. The Marshall Mars flew the approximately 500 miles in two hours and 54 minutes.

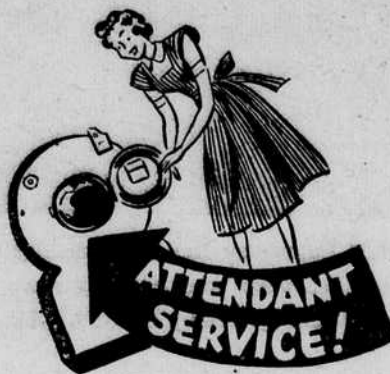


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
