

### Education Chief To Speak Here

John Dale Russell, director of the Division of Higher Education in the U. S. Office of Education, will speak on the Oregon campus Nov. 16.

Russell will be the principal speaker at the second annual conference of presidents and executive officers of universities and colleges in Oregon, which is holding its one-day conference here.

Institutions of higher education throughout Oregon will be represented at the meeting. Panel discussions by Oregon educators will follow talks by Russell.

Subjects to be discussed by Russell are "A National Scholarships Program," and "Problems of Accreditation at the College and University Level." He has chosen these topics as of major concern to institutions of higher education.

This will be Russell's first such visit to Oregon since he was appointed to the Office of Education in 1946. Formerly he was professor of education and associate dean of the division of social sciences at the University of Chicago. He was graduated from Indiana University from which he also has his M. A. and Ph.D. degrees.

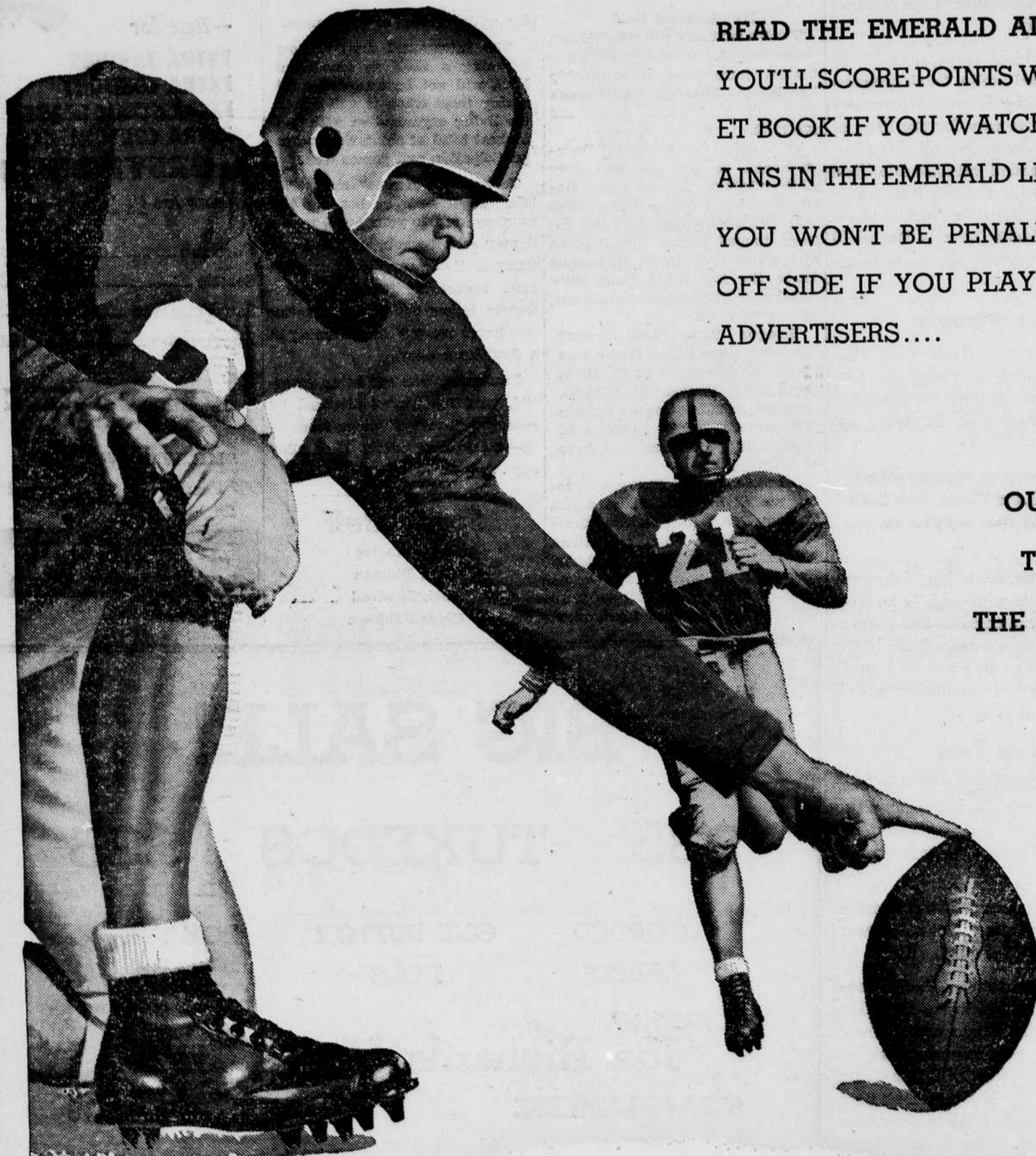
