The students, member of a secret subversive society, Kappa Iota Lambda (KILL), may not hold any elective AS-UO offices in the future.


However, Donald Shoeshine, director of Student Affairs, said that this restriction may be waived in certain cases, although the U.O., he explained, does not treat lightly the serious implications
