

282 Make UO Fall Term Honor Roll

Eighty-two of the 282 students term honor roll of the University of Oregon both in the numbers placing on the roll and those making perfect grade scores.

Eighty-two of the 182 students listed on the total honor roll are Eugene students. Ten of the 30 students making perfect score of 4.00 or all A grades are Eugene students. Seventeen other Lane county students placed on the roll and two of the 17 are Springfield students who made 4.00 GPA.
