For only 150 students out of nearly 900 are such hostel facilities_

Imagine spending your school year in a tent, studying with improper lighting, studying without adequate resource material, or studying on an empty stomach. Yet these are the lucky ones! Many more would like to have the opportunity to do just that for they realize the value of an education.

In other parts of India, today students are cutting their slim food budget of rice and gravy twice a day so that they can send funds and supplies to their fellow students in Assam. Cutting down on their already meager diet is no small sacrifice. They care enough to help.

Turing for a moment to the situation at the Heidelberg, University, where out of a student body of 3000, 630 are refugees who have fled from the East Zone, Prussia, or other critical sections. Three hundred students receive a free meal a day, twice as many need it. Yet this year these same students will hold a drive to send funds to students who have more pressing needs than they. They care enough to help.

We say that the students of today will be the leaders of tomorrow but so few of us realize how soon tomorrow is for students in India. A 25 year old man was elected president of the national council in India. Only 25-yet a leader already.
