THE ISSUES

AIMS: The USA party supports the principle of coalition government and party organization by individual and not by living organization. The USA party chooses candidates on the basis of individual merit; the opposing party, according to its constitution, hopes "to promote the best interests of the fraternal organizations . . ."

METHODS: The USA selects its candidates at an open primary election in which any USA member can vote; the candidates of the opposing party are selected by a committee of 32 fraternity or sorority representatives.

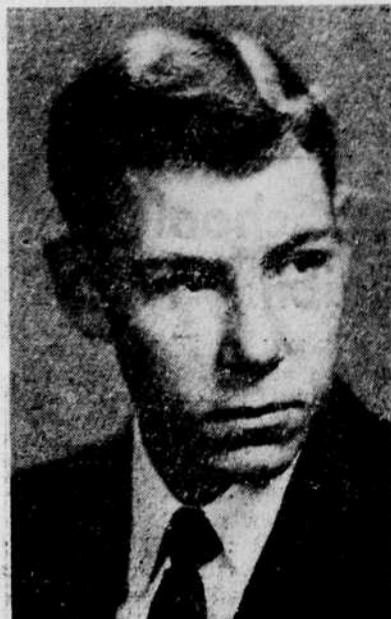
