The University of Oregon Air ROTC program at the present time offers two options in the advanced course-administrattion and logistics and a course in comptrollership. Two additional options will be available for advanced student beginning next fall term. The options are known as General Technical and Flight Operations.

Technical is open to students majoring in science and mathematics. This course is designed to point out primary technical fields and related equipment used in the U.S. Air Force. The subject matter will en-University studies and civilian background in a technical Military Occupational Specialty.

The second new training option is known as Flight Operations. This course is designed to provide instruction which will facilitate and materially augment the academic phases of training in the flying schools of the Air Force. A portion of the instruction will be devoted to include the mission, organization, types of equipment, and method of operations of the major units of the Air Force. The remaining portion of instruction will be devoted to instruction in principles of flight, aircraft engineering, and introduction to instruments, air navigation, meteorology, and new developments in the field


