

New Constitution Governs ASUO; Senate Is Chief Legislative Unit

The Senate is the central body of the Associated Students of the University of Oregon under the new ASUO constitution, which, in general, goes into effect this year.

Composed of the ASUO president, vice-president; the president, vice-president, and two representatives of each of the four classes; nine members elected at large; and two faculty members, the Senate holds all legislative powers of the ASUO. These include approval of appointments made by the ASUO president, control of elections, the power to withhold approval of class activities, election of the yelling, and removal of student administrative and judicial officers. Officers of the Senate, other than the president and vice-president who are the ASUO president and vice-president, are elected by the senate.

Executive Council Gone

The Senate replaces the Executive Council, the governing body of the ASUO under the old constitution. (The new constitution was voted in by the ASUO during spring term of 1950, to go into effect after spring term of this year. The elections of last spring term were conducted under the new constitution, however.)

Assisting the ASUO president and submitting proposals to the Senate is the Cabinet. This body consists of the president, vice-president, and the non-elective officers of the ASUO. Ex-officio non-elective members include the chairman of the Student Union Board, Ralph Hillier; chairman of the Co-op Board, Bill Marshall; Emerald Editor Lorna Larson; Associated Women Students President Nancy Allison; and Director of Student Affairs Donald M. DuShane. Appointed to the cabinet by the ASUO president, subject to Senate approval, are the public relations chairman, social chairman, and athletic chairman.

Also an agent of the ASUO is the Student Union Board.
