

To run for office a candidate must have a 2.00 GPA. It will not be necessary to put down activities or suggestions on petitions. Petitions may be turned to Hampton or the ASUO office,

Nomination Assembly Bules

At the nomination assembly candidates will be introduced by a person of their choice who will be allowed to speak for two minutes on behalf of his candidate. Speeches by candidates will be limited to five minutes.

Offices open will be president, vice president, and two representatives. Candidates will run for the office of their choice. (Under the preferential voting system all candidates are in effect running for president. Voters will mark their ballots numerically, the figure one for the person they wish for president. the figure two for vice president, the figure three for their first choice for representative, the figure four for their second choice for representative.)

Any freshman who is listed by the Registrar's office may vote in the election. Registration cards must be presented and stamped before a freshman may vote.
