● Inter-fraternity council will meet at 7 p.m. Thursday in the Student Union. Nominations for officers will be made and discussion is to be held on the honor code.

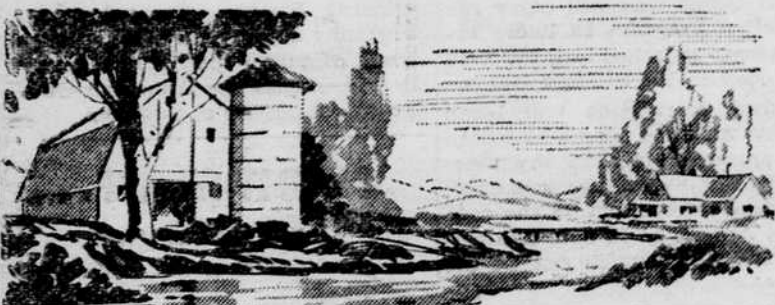
Four to Travel To Conferences
