

Ducks Regain ND Lead, Huskies Whip Beavers

PULLMAN, Wash. — (AP) — University of Oregon took over first place from Oregon State college Friday in the Pacific Coast conference Northern Division baseball race.

The Ducks cashed in on Washington State college errors to defeat the Cougars, 4-2 in 10 innings at Pullman, while the University of Washington Huskies rallied in the eighth inning at Seattle to beat Oregon State, 10-6.

Oregon now has six victories and two losses, while Oregon State has eight wins and four defeats.

The Webfoots tied Buck Bailey's Cougars, 2-2, in the eighth inning on an error and singles by Joe Sugura and Norval Ritchey. Two walks, a single by Daryle Nelson and four Washington State errors gave the Ducks the winning runs in the tenth. It was Oregon's second extra-inning game in three days.

The two teams will clash again today in Pullman.

HALFBACKS—Besides Shaw, the Greenies have a "find" in Tom Elliot, a right halfback, who as a hard runner, shows considerable promise. The other right halves are Farrell Albright and Cece Hodges, who doubles as a fullback.

Behind Shaw will be trackster Ted Anderson, and the Barber twins, Manning and Merritt. The Ducks seem to be fairly deep and from indications, only Tommy Edwards will be missed from the squad.

FULLBACKS — Veteran Tom Novikoff, the pride of Los Angeles, returns for his senior year, and is expected to bear the brunt of the power game. Seconding Novikoff is Dean Van Lueven, a converted end.

Defensively, the tackles and guards on offense will be used. Laird, Reed, Williams and Pheister will be the linebackers, and Lyman, Shaw and Brethauer will form the first line secondary. Shaw will be the safetyman. The Ducks will probably go along with Brethauer on the kickoffs and punts, in addition to Sweitzer. Gary Canova, a sophomore, is being tested for placement duties.
