party, vocational guide filing, election of new officers.

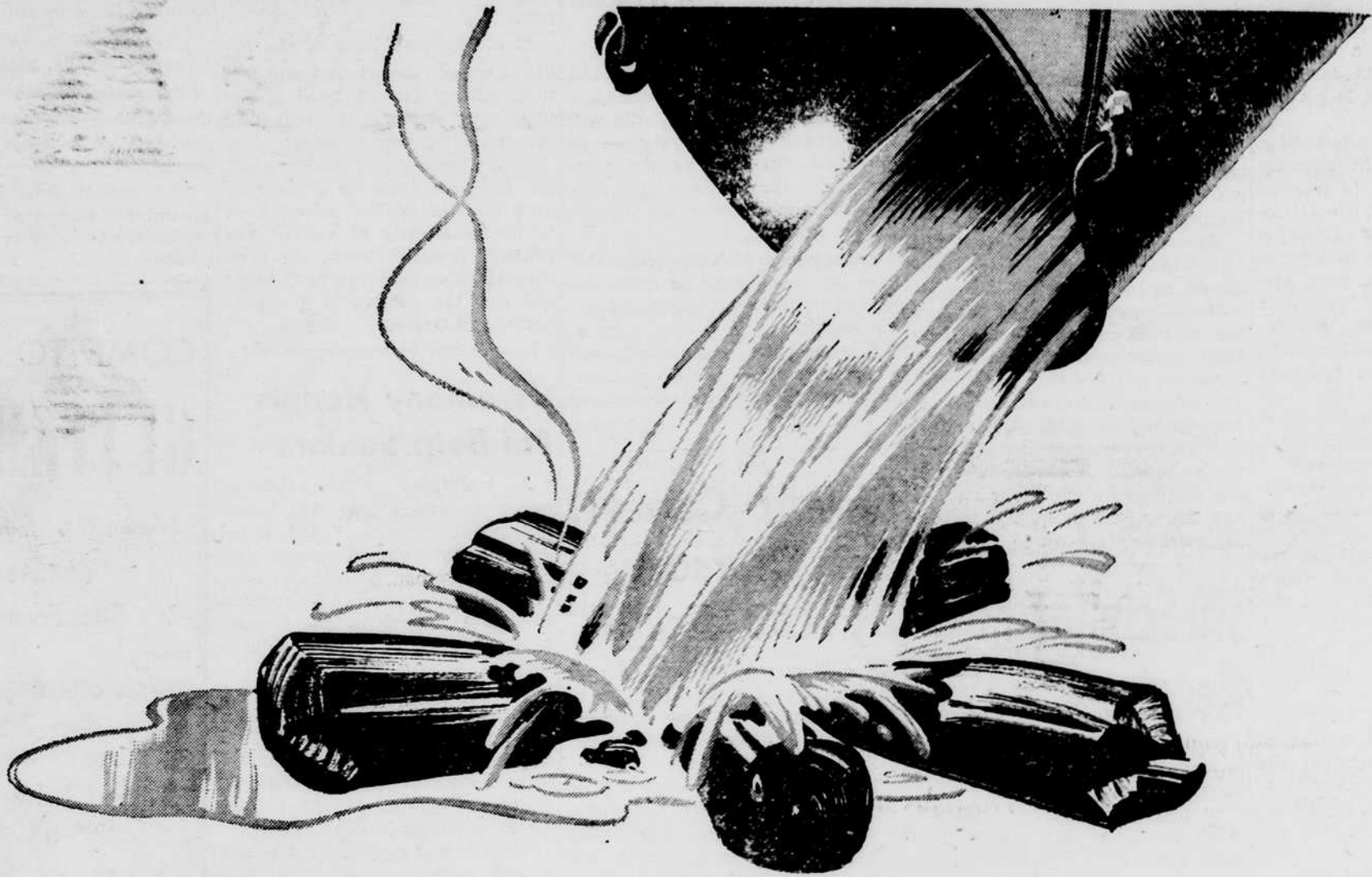
Spring term — The same as spring term, 1952, plus opening of vocational guide and a "Woman's Day".
