

Oregon to Host PCC Championships

Hayward Field Scene Of Cinder Competition

The Pacific Coast Conference track meet will command most of the local sports interest as it comes to Hayward field for its 22nd renewal on Friday and Saturday. Preliminaries will be held on Friday starting at 3:30 p.m., with the finals scheduled for 3:30 on Saturday.

Top Men In Nation

Competing will be some of the nation's brightest stars in track and field. There will be George Brown of the UCLA Bruins who has a broad jump mark which is only five inches under the present world record. Brown is also the defending PCC champion in both the broad jump and the 220-yard dash. Stanford will enter decathlon champion Bob Mathias, who is an attraction in himself—doing :14.3 in the high hurdles, :23.8 in the lows, tossing the shot well over 50 feet, and hurling the discus around 165 feet.

The country's top man in both the high and low hurdles—Jack Davis of USC will also be present, along with local stars Emery Barnes and Jack Hutchins of Oregon, Ken Morgan and George Widenfelt of Washington, Lyle Dickey of Oregon State, and Eric Roberts of Washington State. USC will enter the nation's top weight men in shotputter Parry O'Brien and discus-thrower Sim Iness.

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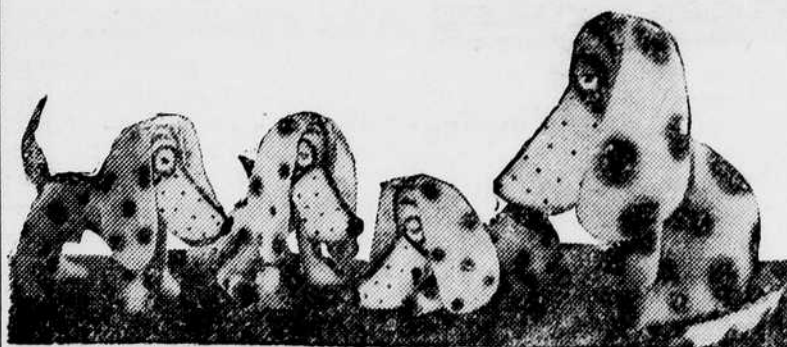
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
