Ducks Top OSC 18-5 In ND League Finale

Playing their spoiler role to the hilt, the University of Oregon Webfoots made life miserable for the Oregon State college Beavers Saturday on Howe field.

The Ducks rebounded from Friday's 7 to 6 defeat to whip the Orange nine, 18 to 5 and prevent them from clinching at least a deadlock for the Pacific Coast Conference Northern division title.

As of Sunday night the University of Washington Huskies led the Beavers by .018. The Seattle team, which is scheduled to wind up its schedule this afternoon in Moscow, Ida. against the University of Idaho's cellar-dwelling Vandals, had a win-loss record of nine and five. Oregon State completed its schedule with a mark of 10 and six.

Co-Champs Possible

In the event of a tie between Washington and Oregon State, there will be no playoff. Instead the two clubs will be crowned co-champions of the Northern division and Oregon State, by virtue of three triumphs in four starts against the Huskies, will entertain the University of Southern California Friday and Saturday at Corvallis for the PCC title.

Bill Mays, who was tagged with an earlier 3 to 1 defeat against the Beavers, hurled for seven and two-third innings to draw credit for the victory. Catcher Norv Ritchey and left fielder Jim Livesay contributed six of 16 Duck hits off of

five Beaver tossers.

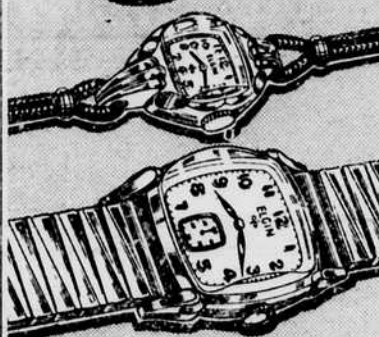
Earl Averill's two-run, eighth-inning round-tripper, which sailed far over the left field bank, was one of the longest clouts of the 1952 season.
