Williams Draws Acclaim

University of Oregon's outstanding guard and linebacker, Emmett Williams Wednesday was named to the United Press' All-Pacific Coast conference football team.

Grid Banquet Tonight

Oregon's outstanding senior football player will be awarded the Hoffman trophy tonight in the Eugene hotel. Announcement of the recipient will follow the banquet, which starts at 5:30 p.m.

Indian Five Invades Mac Court

A pair of race-horse basketball teams, the University of Oregon Ducks and the Stanford university Indians, tip off the 1952-53 home season at 8 tonight in McArthur court. The Oregon frosh will entertain Everybody's Drug store in the preliminary at 5:45 p.m. The two clubs will also clash Saturday night.

Coaches Bill Borchers, starting his second year at the helm of the Webfoots, and Bob Burnett, embarking on his second year as Stanford's head coach, will attempt to find out just how their squads stack up in coast league competition.

The Ducks won't open the Northern Division lid until the first

week of January when they host Washington, but plenty of postage will be riding on the two game series with the Indians. Both clubs, especially Stanford, lost a lot of talent and Borchers and Burnett believe they have the replacements to repair the damages.

Oregon, in its seasonal opener with Oregon State Monday at Portland, lost 72-68 in a five-minute overtime affair, but the Ducks' showing was better than was expected. Borchers will go with the same starters that faced the Beavers—Keith Farnam, Ed Halberg, Chet Noe, Bob Hawes and Ken Wegner.

Farnam, Noe, Hawes and Wegner are all holdovers from the 1951-52 first place club. Halberg, two years ago, was an all-Junior college All-American at Olympic JC in Bremerton, Wash. He is rated as an excellent rebounder and has a good jump shot.

If Borchers follows the same line of substitution that he used in the OSC game, he will insert Bob Stout, Hank Bonneman, Don Sigmund, Howard Page and Paul Poetsch or Barney Holland into the lineup; but in all probability he will use his entire roster of 15.

Coach Don Kirsch's frosh will probably start Don Porter, Ray Bell, Max Anderson, Jerry Ross and Dick James in the prelim.

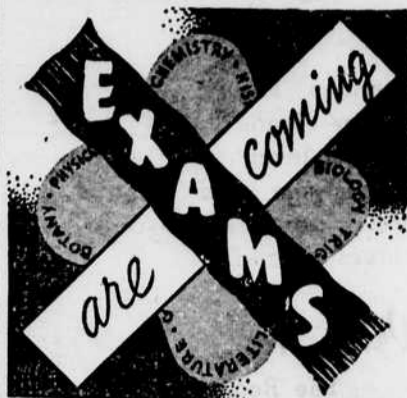
