

Simpson To Give Condon Lectures, Topics of Evolution and Geography

George Gaylord Simpson, chairman of the department of geology and paleontology of the American Museum of Natural History in New York, will give the 1953 Condon lectures at Oregon, L. S. Cressman, head of the anthropology department, announced.

Simpson's first two lectures will be given in the Student Union Jan. 13 and 15. The next two in the series will be given at Oregon State college, Jan. 20 and 22, and the final two at Portland, Jan. 27 and 28.

The Condon Lectureship was originated as a means of giving to the layman knowledge of scientific research and exploration. The series are sponsored by the Oregon state board of higher education.

General topic of this year's lectures will be evolution and geography. The topic will be divided into "The History of Regional Faunas" and "Faunal Relationships Between the Old World and the New." Simpson's illustrated talks will deal with the develop-

ment of zoo-geographic regions, evolution and movements of regional animals and relationships between animals of different land masses.

Simpson, a popular lecturer, is also known for his books on evolution and the interpretation of science. His lectures on the campus will be open to the public at no charge.

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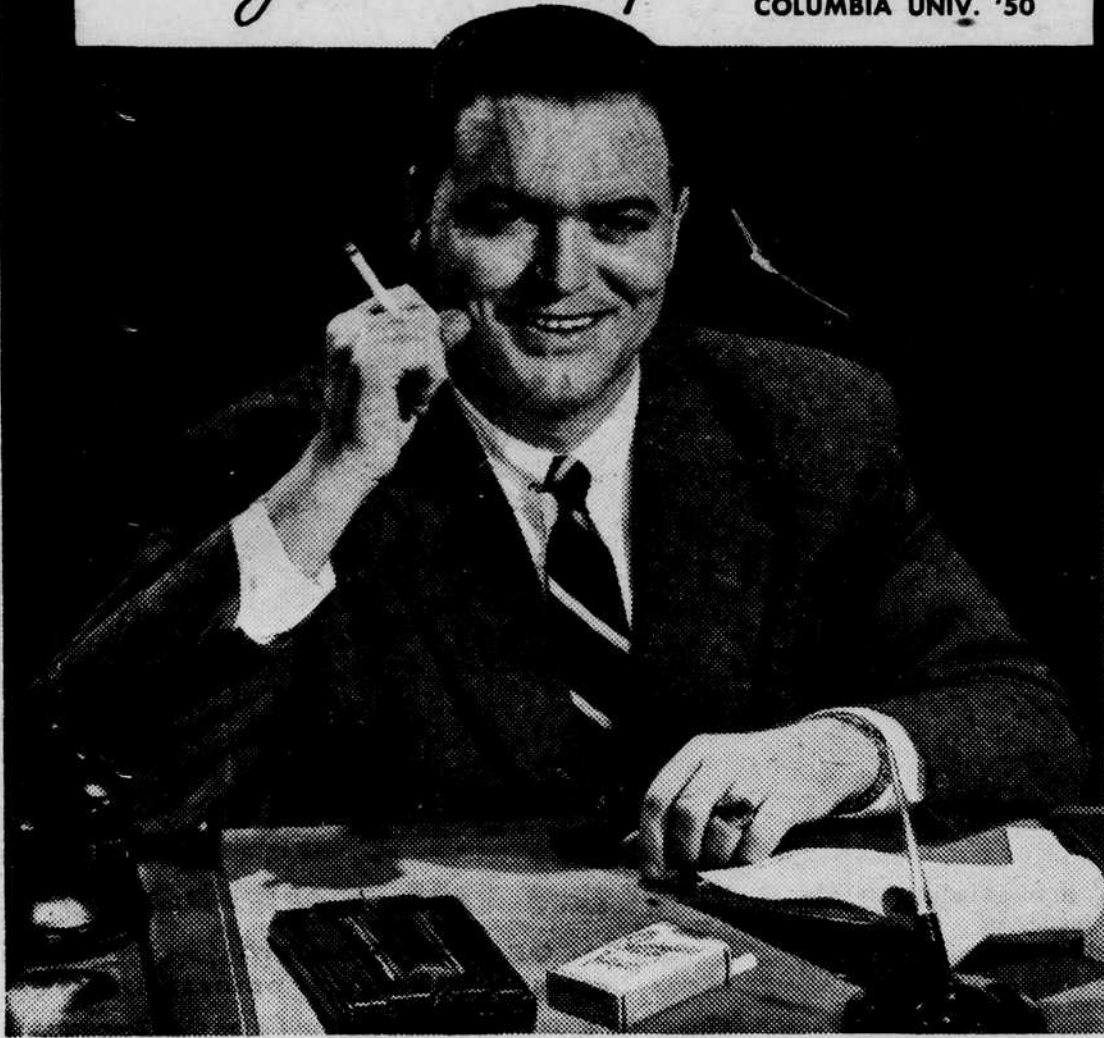
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
