April 3 Deadline For Grad Record **Exam Applications**

Students who plan to take graduate record examinations on April 17 and 18 must have their application filed in Los Angeles by April 3, according to the University counseling center, where the application blanks are available.

The tests will be given in three one-half day sessions: profile, Friday afternoon; aptitude, Saturday morning; and advanced, Saturday afternoon. A fee of \$12 will be charged for all three sessions, \$10 for two sessions and \$8 for one.

The advanced tests may be taken in any one of the following fields: biology, chemistry, economics, education, engineering, French, geology, German, government, history, literature, mathematics, philosophy physics, psychology, sociology and Spanish.

Those interested in taking the test should consult with the head of the department in which they are taking their masters to see if the examinations are required, the counseling center reported.
