Ed Halberg Injures Head

Oregon's hopes for a week-end series sweep over the Idaho Vandals were given a serious blow Monday afternoon when the Ducks' star forward, Ed Halberg, received a bad gash on his head that required several stitches to mend.

Halberg collided with guard Barney Holland during a scrimmage session as the two players were rushing headlong for a loose ball.
