Traffic Deaths Cut in Oregon

The National Safety council has advised Oregon officials that the state's 19 per cent reduction in traffic deaths last year was the best in the nation.

Utah was second with a 15 per cent reduction. Washington cut day at 4 p. m. in the Student Units traffic deaths 14 per cent, California 4 per cent and Idaho 9 per

On the other side of the ledger, Oregon had a two per cent increase in the number of traffic injuries.
