

The coast commissioner's office also announced that the other three positions on the team went to Dean Parsons of Washington, Bob Garrison of Idaho, and Barney Holland of Oregon.

For a second team the Northern Division coaches picked Ed Halberg of Oregon and Karl Voegtlin of Washington at the forward positions; Dwight Morrison of Idaho at center; and Ken Wegner of Oregon and Tom Flynn of Idaho at the guard posts. In their first series of the season at Pullman, WSC won the first game 56-48 but lost the second fray to the Huskies 54-44.


