

ASUO Senate Has Three Vacancies

Because ASUO senator-at-large Don Smith failed to make his grades last spring, the senate will have three vacancies to fill Thursday instead of the expected two.

Smith's position will be filled by petition. He was elected on the AGS ticket and is a sophomore.

Any student is eligible to petition for Smith's job and for the vacancy created when Tom

Arata, also a senator-at-large, failed to return to school this fall. Arata ran independently in last spring's election.

The third vacancy is open to any junior. UIS' junior class representative, Russ Cowell, is not in school this year.

All petitions are due in the ASUO president's office in the Student Union before 5 p.m. Thursday.

Junior Fills AGS Vice-Presidency

Don Bonime, junior in liberal arts, was elected vice-president of Associated Greek Students, campus political party, at Thursday's meeting.

Milan Foster, senior in business, was the only other candidate. It was also decided by the party to request that all AGS senators attend future party meetings.

Three positions are open in Skull and Dagger, sophomore men's service honorary, President Doug Basham has announced.

The vacancies, which were not filled last spring term, will be filled by petition. ASUO petitions are to be used and may be obtained on the third floor of the

Student Union.

Sophomore men who wish to petition must have a 2 point GPA. No more than three members from one living organization may petition, Basham emphasized. Petitions are to be turned in at the ASUO petition box on the third floor of the SU.

Chairmen Needed For RE Program

Petitions are still needed for three chairmanships of the Religious Emphasis week program. Openings for community, fire-side and worship chairman are still to be filled.

Two executive council positions also are to be filled by petition. The two are special events chairman and secretary.
