

US Hails Ladies in White; Shortage Remains Acute

National Nurse week, by act of Congress and presidential proclamation, lasts Monday through Saturday of this week and honors the nearly 400,000 registered professional nurses and 75,000 licensed practical nurses currently caring for patients in the nation.

At the University, eight registered nurses are employed. At least one registered nurse is on duty at all times.

The nurse shortage in America remains acute. More than 50,000 professional nurses are needed to meet essential civilian demands. Another 60,000 practical nurses, if available, could be employed this year.

There are two types of professional nursing education programs: Diploma programs open to high school graduates which

are three years and offered by hospital schools of nursing; degree programs, four or five years offered by a college or university, and leading to a degree in nursing. Both prepare students for licensure and practice as a professional nurse.

Presently more than 102,000 students are enrolled in professional schools of nursing and another 9,000 are in schools of practical nursing.
