

College Drinking Named as Topic

The topic, "Is There a College Drinking Problem?" will be the theme of the Roberts Editorial Awards contest of 1955. Prizes and scholarships totaling \$2400 will be awarded to college students who submit editorials written on that theme by May 1. Each editorial must be at least 500 words in length but is not to exceed 800 words.

The contest is open to any full-time undergraduate student. No student who has written professionally is eligible. The general theme of the contest is "Drinking in College." Editorials may deal with any phase of the theme and each writer shall select his own title. Judging of research, clarity of expression and accuracy of basic facts.

Russia to Supply Atomic Material

MOSCOW - (AP) - The Soviet government announced Monday it will provide fissionable material and technical assistance for peaceful atomic development in Communist China, East Germany, Poland, Romania and Czechoslovakia.

In return, according to an official statement by the council of ministers, the five Communist allies will keep a continuing supply of atomic raw materials flowing to Russia.

The announcement, made at a hurriedly called conference for foreign newsmen at the Foreign Ministry, stressed that the Soviet assistance will be "for peaceful aims."

Experimental atomic piles set up under the program will be limited to those required for the production of 5000 kilowatts of electrical power. No mention was made of atomic weapons.

Friday the Soviets had offered to share their findings on industrial use of atomic energy at a congress that the United Nations assembly is planning for this summer. This offer to share know-how on atomic production of electricity was viewed in the West as an effort to counter President Eisenhower's atom-for-peace plan.

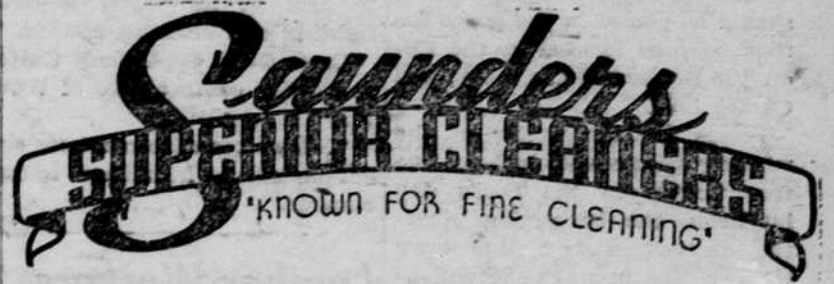
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
