Each grant also includes travel expenses inside Italy, and payment for private lessons for music students. Trans-Atlantic travel and incidental expenses are not included.

The University of Padua in Italy offers two tuition and maintenance scholarships to men and women under 35. Preference is given to men.

Must Have Master's

Candidates for the Italian government awards must have a master's degree, and present in detailed outline form a project for advanced study or research. Candidates who are accepted must learn some Italian before taking up their fellowships.

Candidates for the College of Ghislieri and University of Padua awards must have a bachelor's degree at the time the fellowship is taken up and a good knowledge of Italian.

SummerInstitute Offered in East
