

Mother's Weekend Begins

The annual breakfast-business meeting and program for mothers will be held at 8:45 a.m. in the Student Union ballroom.

Guest speaker for the breakfast will be University President O. Meredith Wilson. Audrey Mistretta will be guest soloist. John Richards, chancellor-elect, and his wife will attend, as will Gordon Wilson, president of the Dads' club. Election of officers for the coming year will be held.

Mothers and all students on campus will attend the luncheon, to be held on old campus this noon, when the Junior Weekend Court will be presented and the queen honored.

A tea, sponsored by the Eugene Mothers' club will be held from 2 to 4:30 p.m. in Gerlinger hall. Awards will be presented at the tea at 3:00.

Dinner this evening will be in the living organizations, and the canoe fete will be the attraction for this evening. The canoe fete will begin at 8:30 p.m.

Sunday morning there will be breakfast in the living organizations. Church will follow, with Sunday dinner again in the living organizations. The all-campus sing will be held Sunday afternoon at 2 p.m.

The following buildings and departments will open for visits by the mothers between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Saturday: Virgil Earl Hall, new men's dormitory, opened in honor of the mothers for its first public inspection; Carson Hall; the new Eric Allen journalism school; the Oriental Art and Natural History Museum; the University Theater.

'Sing' Contests Started in 1941

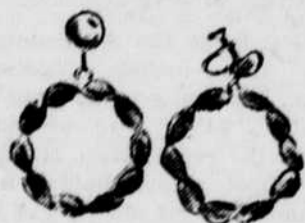
In the spring of 1941 the Order of the "O" sponsored an informal dance known as the "Lemon Squeeze." Extra-special intermission entertainment was singing competition among three men's organizations and three women's organizations which had survived previous eliminations. This was the beginning of what has become a major event of Junior Weekend, the All Campus Sing.

The first "Sing" was such a success that in 1942 the number of participants was increased and it was held in Mac Arthur Court the last Saturday night in April.

It was in 1943 that the All Campus Sing became a Junior Weekend event when it was held on Saturday night in place of the canoe fete. The fete had to be replaced by a float parade through the streets of Eugene in the afternoon because of the war and disrepair of the mill race.

First winners of the cups presented by Panhellenic and the Inter-Fraternity Council in 1941 were Gamma Phi Beta and Delta Tau Delta. Winners since that time have been Alpha Omicron Pi, Alpha Tau Omega, 1942; Alpha Gamma Delta, Campbell Club-Kirkwood Co-op, 1943; Kappa Alpha Theta, no men's trophy awarded, 1944; Delta Gamma, Sherry Ross, 1945; Chi Omega, Omega, 1946; Delta Gamma, Sigma Alpha Epsilon,

1947; Alpha Phi, Sigma Nu, Alpha Epsilon, 1951; Pi Beta Phi, Sigma Phi Epsilon, 1952; Chi Omega, Minturn Hall, 1950; Alpha Phi, Sigma Phi, Sigma Phi Epsilon, 1953; Carson Hall, Campbell Club,
