With the aid of a torn print dress Gina Lollobrigida romps through the hilarious film, "Bread, Love and Dreams," now at the Mayflower. This Italian film tells the laughable story of a middle-aged and dignified police marshal who becomes entangled with a fiery woman (Lollo) in love with a handsome but bashful young rustic on his force.
