# Maryland in Top Spot Following UCLA Upset

Maryland, conqueror of topranked UCLA, barely beat out Michigan Tuesday for No. 1 place in The Associated Press college football poll.

In handing the Pacific Coast champions their first shutout in 40 games, 7-0, Jim Tatum's Terrapins rocketed from fifth to first in the weekly standings on a thumping vote from 135 of the nation's sports writers and broadcasters.

Although Michigan received the greater number of first place votes, 48 to 45, Maryland gained enough all-around voting strength to head the list with 1,113 points. Michigan, 42-7 winner over Missouri in its debut, drew 1,032

Points are awarded on the basis of ten for a first place vote, nine for second and on down the line.

The first full Saturday of games so shuffled the standings that only one position in the top ten-Southern California-remained stationary.

Behind Maryland and Michigan, in order, came Georgia Tech, No. 3; Notre Dame, No. 4; Oklahoma, No. 5; Army, No. 6; UCLA, No. 7: Ohio State, No. 8; Southern California, No. 9; and Texas Christian, No. 10.

Of these, Notre Dame, Army and Texas Christian are newcomers, rooting out Pittsburgh, Mississippi and Navy because of impressive opening performances.

UCLA fell from the top to seventh after its defeat, ending a 10-game winning streak for Red Sanders' charges. Georgia Tech, 14-7 winner over Florida, dropped from second to third.
