# 'Limelight,' Starring Chaplin Is Best Film Showing Now

"Limelight," a replay of Charlie Chaplin's film seen two years ago on campus, is by far the best film showing this weekend.

Chaplin plays Calvero, a music hall comedian around the time of the first world war. He helps a ballet dancer who claims she can no longer walk. She becomes a great star while he becomes a street entertainer.

Included in the film are too few scenes of Chaplin's famous vaudeville skits. He plays the "tramp" he is so famous for, does a flea routine, and teams up with Buster Keaton in a violin act which is one of the high-points of the show.


### Freshman Rally Interviews Oct. 11
